The Community Toy Store is designed to serve families that are having a difficult time financially. It gives them opportunity to experience the joy and dignity of personally providing for their children this Christmas season.

New toys are donated with the price tags still on, as well as gift cards, and then the prices are cut by 75-90%, allowing parents to shop at the reduced prices. Free gift wrapping is provided, and childcare is offered while parents shop. All proceeds from the sales at the Toy Store are then donated to non-profit programs, such as Rebound of Whatcom County and The Whatcom Dream, thus allowing families to be recipients and contributors.

The Community Toy Store is a partnership between local organizations, churches, and community members. It will be held at Roosevelt Elementary School on Saturday, December 17.
