Reverend J. R. Williams was born in Milwaukee, Wisconsin on July 19, 1980. He united with Providence Baptist Church in 1991 and was baptized by Founder and Pastor Joe A. Games. In 1998 he graduated from James Madison High School. In 2004 he married Joanelle Jackson and is the proud father of two girls, Gabrielle 5 yrs. old and Madison who is 2 yrs. old.

While under the leadership of Pastor Games, he served as a Sunday School Teacher at Providence, and taught at the nearby Hampton Gardens Senior Center. He also served God and man as a Deacon before he received his call to preach the Word of God in March of 2007. He was licensed to preach on May 12th 2007, and was ordained on March 19th, 2011.

He is the former “Bible 101” and “Religious Studies” Teacher at CEO Leadership Academy. He currently works as a second grade assistant teacher at Young Leaders Academy and attends Concordia University where he is a senior majoring in Business with a minor in Theology. He teaches in the Youth Department of the “Wisconsin General Baptist State Congress of Christian Education”.
