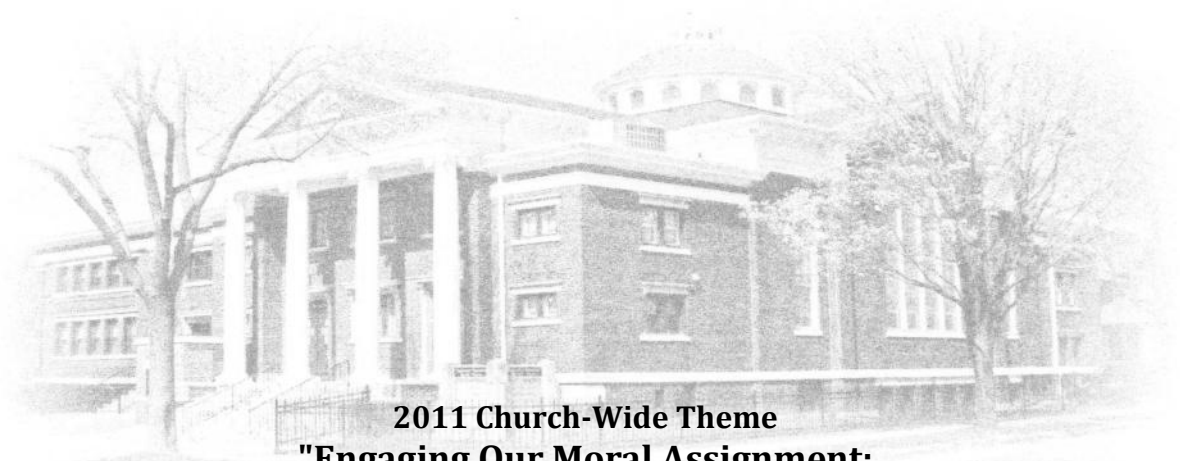

Talk about being overwhelmed! I was thrilled by the number of members and guests who participated in the first teaching session of TIPS for Growth and the commissioning of AWANA last Wednesday. We had almost 200 adults in Bible Study and over 30 children and youth in AWANA. The energy-level was high and members were excited. (For me, it was like Christmas!) What delighted me most was the high turnout of first-time members in Bible Study. That is a sign that we are making significant commitments to becoming a growing church--growing in faith, fellowship and knowledge of God's word. I was also impressed by members who had invited guests to share the event. Since ours is an evangelical faith, we must witness it to others so they may come to experience what we have found in Jesus Christ.

During the prayer service, we commissioned our AWANA Ministry (Approved Workers Are Not Ashamed - 2 Timothy 2:15) for our children and youth (ages 2-18), anointing the hands of leaders and volunteers for the program. I am told they had a blast in their opening carnival. In the coming weeks, we will present all leaders and volunteers to the congregation so parents and guardians can establish working relationships with them. I encourage members to bring your children and youth to this important ministry program which is designed to teach them to know, love and serve Jesus Christ.

ORDINARY TIME

In the context of the liturgical year the term “ordinary” means “not seasonal.” It is that part of the church year that lies outside the seasons of Lent-Easter and Advent-Christmas. In Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the mystery of Christ not in one specific aspect but in all its aspects.

Ordinary Time in the Church's year occurs in two sections. The first part begins following the Christmas season. It lasts through the Tuesday before Ash Wednesday, and resumes after Pentecost. The Liturgical color for Ordinary Time is green.
