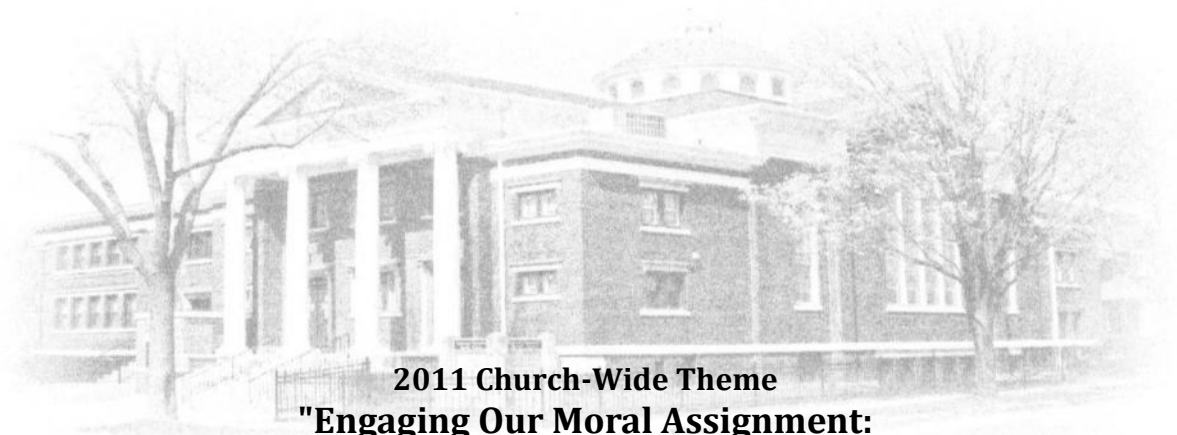

It warms my heart to see the congregation's generosity in action. Even before today, members have been bringing donations to the church in response to the call to sacrifice. LITURGICAL NOTES: ORDINARY TIME

A modern expression to denote the periods of the liturgical year which lie outside principal seasons, a shorter span from the end of the Christmas or Epiphany season to the beginning of Lent and a considerably longer one from Pentecost to the beginning of Advent.

In Ordinary Time, the Church celebrates the mystery of Christ not in one specific aspect but in all its features. Green is the Liturgical color for this season.
