### Leadership

Additional Input: The distinction between the gift of administration and leadership must be made. Two different Greek words are used. Administration (kubernesis) means to steer or guide as a helmsman. An administrator works more on the accomplishment of goals whereas a leader is the one who is more a goal-setter.

- Acolyte Coordinator (vacant) - Coordinates and schedules the acolytes. Trains children in the importance of the preparation of the altar before each service. - Beyond 50 Ministry - This adult ministry is for older members of the congregation. The group is led by its own members and works on intergenerational ministry.
