Developing Faith

We have to develop our faith in order to handle spiritual weight. Finding a scripture to match a situation is the number one thing in developing your faith. In Luke 17:11-19, Jesus told ten lepers to go and show themselves to the priest. As they went they were cleaned. Only one of the ten returned to give praise to God. Jesus told the one whom returned, "Arise go thy way; thy faith has made thee whole". (Verse 19) Whole means nothing lacking, totally restored. The other nine were healed but not made whole. It is time for you to praise God so He can restore and give back to you what has been stolen. Plant your seed and praise your way through the process.

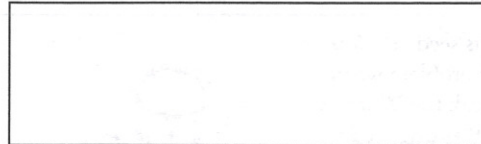
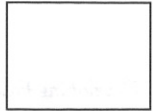
