

This is for seniors who want to commit five hours a week to intense discipleship, ministry training, active ministry and accountability. Our goal is to see our seniors challenged spiritually and grow to ultimately become stronger in their walk with the Lord their senior year.

The expectations are as follows:

1. Meet with other seniors and the Youth Pastor once a week for Bible study, accountability and prayer.
2. Spend at least two hours a week on a Bible study that is assigned by the youth pastor.
3. Work at least one and a half hours a week on a specific area of ministry training. You and the youth pastor will determine that area and you will work with the person in charge of that specific area of ministry.

Who can apply?

- Must be a senior in high school
- Must have at least three months of Servant Leader experience
- Must have a stable and consistent walk with Jesus
- Must have a love for people, Psalm 1
- Must live a life above reproach. This means that when people see your walk with God, there is no doubt that you serve God 100%. Titus 1:1-7. As leaders, youth will look up to you. It is important that you hold high moral standards. No one is perfect, but it is important you do your best to avoid the following areas:
 - a. You should not associate with drinking, smoking or drugs
 - b. You should have a clean mouth . . . NO profanity
 - c. You should not gossip or speak bad things about people
 - d. You should hold biblical standards on dating and sex as taught by Breakthrough.

If you have any problems with any of these areas, you are to let the Youth Pastor know immediately so that he can help you deal with it appropriately.

- Hebrews 10:24-25 “And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together”. With this in mind, it is important you attend Sunday morning services and youth services faithfully. You should also attend all the major youth events including: fun nights, outreaches, Ignite, Frontline, camp, Christmas dinner, etc.

How long?

Each mentorship is three months long. After three months are up the senior may apply for another three months if they wish to.

To apply, fill out the application and turn it into the Youth Pastor.
