- 1) Pride - Judgmental, condemning others, look for the approval of others
- 2) Greed - Discontent with the spiritual journey God has given us; comparing to others
- 3) Luxury - Pleasure in blessings more than God himself
- 4) Wrath - Easily irritated, lack of sweetness, no patience to wait upon God
- 5) Spiritual Gluttony - You love the Christian life but don’t want it to involve the cross or our own crucifixion
- 6) Spiritual Envy - Unhappy (jealous) when others do well spiritually
- 7) Root of Sloth - Run from the hard things, looking for the easy way out
