We too will let our little lights shine in the hopes that others will be led to Jesus as well. Will you pray about your part in our outreach? We will need folks to pray, prepare brochures, form and train teams, and follow up with those whom we visit. I pray this Christmas season of holy and family celebrations is all that you hoped it would be.
