From the Pastor

he commentator

At the break of day on the first Easter morning, the command to those first witnesses to the resurrection was "Go... tell...!" Here's the thing – that command has never been retracted. For those of us who have "seen" ...are now sent to "share." From the outset, the church has never been a spectator event – there are no mere observers – or as a friend of mine once put it "we aren't called to be pew potatoes!" It's about mission. It's always been that way.

Sometimes we can get distracted from this primary task of mission by a variety of things. Discouragement. Apathy. Fear. Conflict. Unc ertainty. Did you nod your head at any of those items? Or have you got a few additions of your own? Yep – we can own it. But before we start feeling insecure in our mission, take courage in the knowledge that these things (and more!) have been the challenge of the church from the beginning. Read the Book of Acts and the letters of Paul to the early churches. If our experience is even a dim reflection of the disorder that they experienced attempting to live out their mission ...then the timeless grace, mercy, forgiveness and inspiration of the Holy Spirit is more powerfully relevant for us today!

In this Easter season, I invite you to join in some conversation about our mission as the people of Atonement Lutheran Church. We'll be answering some questions: Who Are We? Why Are We Here? Who is Our Neighbor? As we explore these questions, we'll gain a clearer understanding about our identity, purpose and context. Make a point of attending the Adult Forums in the month of April to participate in these discussions – as we explore the Bible and offer some reflection on what it means for us as a church. As stated above – there are no spectators – the input of everyone is vital to our conversation. See you there!
