FROM THE PASTOR

Far too often, I hear from good people just like you "I know I'm a person of faith... but it just feels like something is missing." If you've ever said – or thought – this, then you're not alone. Generations of Christians – going all the way back to the first disciples and multitudes who gathered at Jesus' feet – have confessed likewise. And in response to all of them, Jesus has extended the beautiful invitation to a faith journey with the simple words, "Follow me."

The invitation to Lent is an invitation to journey with Christ to the cross, to remember our dependence on God, and to gaze with faith toward the resurrection to come. For many Christians, the season is marked by four spiritual practices found in the invitation to Lent on Ash Wednesday:

"I invite you, therefore, to the discipline of Lent – self-examination and repentance, prayer and fasting, sacrificial giving, and works of love – strengthened by the gifts of Word and Sacrament. Let us continue our journey through these forty days to the great Three Days of Jesus' death and resurrection!" (ELW – Ash Wednesday invitation)

During Lent, you are invited to enter more deeply into your faith journey by reflecting on what the four Lenten practices of 1.) repentance, 2.) prayer and fasting, 3.) sacrificial giving and 4.) works of love mean for you today. We will have the following materials available for you:

- 40 Days of Giving Calendar
- Weekly "Story Telling" bulletin inserts
- Giving Jar Label
- Sunday morning Adult Forum sessions (more information in this newsletter)

May these in-home resources, study opportunities, stories from others, and giving challenges aid you in your life of faith.

But more importantly, may God bless your Lenten Journey. And may your practices of the discipline of Lent enrich your faith and your commitment to sharing the work that God is doing in this world!
