

### **PASTOR'S PAGE**

The Good News echoes into these coming months — "Christ is Risen!" — as we celebrate that which God has accomplished. Christ is Risen! as we celebrate Affirmation of Baptism for our Confirmands. Christ is Risen! as we complete yet another year of Sunday School education. Christ is Risen! as we bless the High School Seniors upon their graduation. "Christ is Risen, Indeed!" And Christ is Risen! not only serves as a victorious proclamation upon the completion of our tasks, but also offers a challenge into the future. Imagine the wonder, amazement and fear of those first followers of Christ as they considered what uncertainties the days and years ahead of them would hold!

This Summer, we will be preparing for challenge with a Capital Appeal Campaign in the Fall. At our Annual Meeting in January, we discussed the need and timeliness of this appeal. Our Council is considering three parts to the Capital Campaign Appeal:

- 1. Debt Reduction which will allow us to reduce our Building Fund Debt (currently \$1.2M), reduce our monthly mortgage payment, and free up funds for program ministry namely resuming our Youth and Family staff position.
- 2. New Capital Improvement Project which is not yet identified, however we are considering some projects that will

permit us to expand usability of our property for ministry and reduce our tax obligation for the unused acreage.

3. Tithe – Atonement has a long history of blessing ministries and programs beyond our walls and are planning to do this as part of our Appeal to both practice and model benevolence in our financial stewardship.

We will be using the services of Mission Investment Fund – Capital Campaign Services with Rev. Dana Petersen as our resource person. We will be assembling a Leadership Team thru the Summer in preparation for a Kick-Off Sunday on October 13 and a Commitment Sunday on November 17. Please begin prayerful consideration as to your involvement and support of this wonderful challenge before us.

We even proclaim Christ is Risen! as we move into new patterns and schedules with the beginning of our combined Summer worship at 9:15am beginning Memorial Day Weekend. It has been our opportunity to celebrate our unity as the Body of Christ as we connect with those who worship at the alternate times.

Blessings to you as you proclaim that which has been accomplished by God in your life – and rise to the challenges in the days ahead – with Christ is Risen!"
