ADOPT-A-PLOT YEAR 2

From the Stewardship Campaign in November and review of the Time & Talent sheets, the Property Committee will be continuing the Adopt-a-Plot program. The program is aimed at having congregational members take ownership of landscaped "plots" for weeding, trimming, and general upkeep. The plots are sized to allow for completion of a section in several hours. The plot is owned by an adopting member or family and needs to be kept up throughout the year. The Property Committee can supply guidelines for the upkeep, such as how far to cut down the grasses and how much of a bush should be trimmed, providing consistency from one plot to another.

The Atonement landscaped property has been divided into 35 plots. Over 25 congregational families take care of these plots. The Property Committee is asking members to continue their assigned plots for 2020. If you are unable to maintain your plots, please inform any member of the Property Committee and we can assign another family. At this time there are about 8 plots that do not have anyone assigned to maintain. During the months of March and April, the assigned area posters will be displayed on Sundays with the open areas identified. Tentatively, 9:00am on April 18th has been set for the first Clean-up Day and will be a great opportunity to spiff up the grounds before Confirmation. With the enormous increase in grass areas requiring mowing, the Property Committee Mowing Team would like to thank each and every volunteer for their commitment to keeping our grounds in great shape. Should you still be interested in a plot, please contact Todd Koepp or Ryan Kapperud and we will find a location for you.
