FAMILY PROMISE NEWS

Atonement Lutheran Church will again host the families of Family Promise at the Day Center, July 17-23. These are families who do not currently have housing and are work in partnership with the staff at FP to become financially independent. Families who have worked with FP have had extraordinary success over the years at getting secure housing and active employment after their intense efforts to change their lives. FP families continue to live in the four Transitional Housing apartments and at the FP Day Center until it is safe to return to the congregations in the community. By being the weekly host, we are responsible for nightly suppers for one family: a mom and three children: 7 yrs., 4 yrs. and 5 yrs. Exact information will be given to those who volunteer to deliver an evening meal to the FP Day Center (10 South 26th Street, Billings) involving going through the locked door to the kitchen on the first floor and putting the food in the fridge or on the counter. Please contact Lorraine Theurer (245-4400) if you can prepare part of a meal, or a whole meal. In addition, the following is a list of donations needed for the families: diapers, wipes, hand soap, twin beds, twin bedding, household cleaning products, gift cards (gas card, grocery), winter boots and coats in all sizes, totes with lids, Welcome Home Baskets, silverware, infant car seats (not expired) and infant pack and plays. If you can help with any of these items, bring to Atonement and we will get them to FP or for pickup, call Janie and Tom

HETZEL GRANT 2022 UPDATE

Earlier this spring Atonement Lutheran Church applied for another grant from the William and Blanche Hetzel Foundation, Inc. to be used for enhancements of our campus. Previously we have received Hetzel grants in 2017and 2019 that resulted in the creation of connectivity sidewalks between Atonement and WyndStone on our shared campus and a soft-surface walking trail. This 2022 grant requested funds for further improvements including irrigation, plants, more polywood benches for use of the surrounding neighborhood around our sidewalks and further projects to finish the area around the Memorial Garden. We were thrilled to received \$5000, although this is only a portion of what we requested, and we will have to adjust our project accordingly for now. If these projects can be completed by March of 2023, we can complete our report and apply for another grant in 2023. If you are interested in assisting with these projects and helping write the next grant leave your name with the church office.
