


Catch the Vision—Share the Hope Building Campaign Goal Within Reach!

Dear Friends at Atonement,

This month my letter is a bit of a potpourri of thoughts.

First of all . . . I am still euphoric over the response to **Catch the Vision – Share the Hope** Commitment Sunday. On that Sunday alone we received 92% of our Capital Campaign Goal. Over the next several weeks there will be more commitments coming in and I am optimistic that we will reach or exceed our \$650,000 goal. I truly feel that the Holy Spirit is moving among us and that you, the members of Atonement, have generously responded to the Holy Spirit's urgings! Thank you, thank you, thank you!!!

With this successful response, ground breaking on our new building is not far away. We will be making another application to the Mission Loan Fund within the next week (I'm writing on May 25th) and we should have a response two to three weeks after that. If all goes well, we hope to be breaking ground by the first week of July. These are exciting times. We will keep you informed. We will post information regarding ongoing Capital Campaign results on the website and each week at worship. We ask that those who have not made commitments yet to please do so by June 20th as that will be our wrap up date for the Capital Campaign. As soon as we know what day we will do our ground breaking we will share that information with you as well.

Don't forget that we are having a big weekend on June 23rd and 24th. We will have the Country Fair on Saturday and Worship on Sunday. **Please note that the 9:45 Service on the 24th will actually take place at 10:00 in the tent up by the Little White Church**. See the article elsewhere in this newsletter regarding all the specifics of the weekend. We will be celebrating the end of our successful Capital Campaign that Sunday.

We are only two and one half months away from welcoming our Intern for the coming year, Jenna Pulkowski. She will be beginning her internship on August 13th. I am in the beginning stages of getting the Internship Committee set up. Last month I asked for volunteers, but I haven't had any forthcoming yet. Since there are some things that need to be done fairly soon. I will be contacting some of you to see if you would be willing to serve. If there is anyone who would like to volunteer, please contact me immediately. Serving on the Internship Committee is an interesting and rewarding experience. You will also have a valuable part in training a future pastor of the church.

School is coming to an end for this academic year. That means we will all start going about our summer activities. Don't forget, if you cannot make Sunday worship due to your summer activities, we are holding Wednesday Evening worship services up at the Little White Church. The services begin at 7:00 p.m. and run about 45 minutes. The lesson and sermon will be from the previous Sunday.


Blessings to each of you as we move into summer and into our future as Atonement Lutheran Church with God's blessing, love and guidance.
