

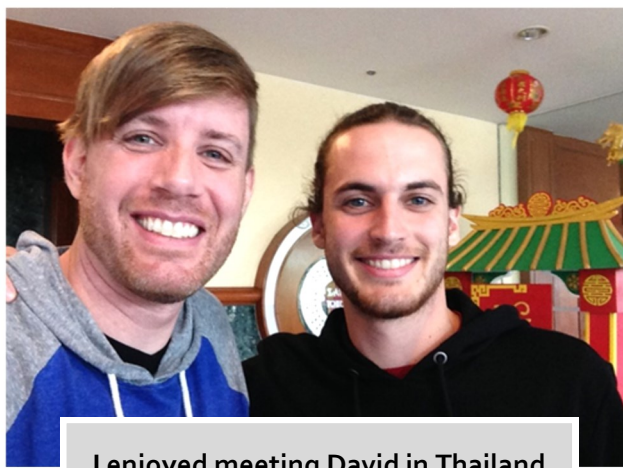
STAYING IN TUNE—WITH THE LOOS FAMILY

He rejected what he heard. However, one of James' teachers at school happened to be a believer and encouraged James to read the Bible.

Fast forward several months later, James met David (pictured right) who had just arrived in this country on a one year missionary trip. David shared the gospel with him in one of their first conversations and this time he put his faith in Christ. In fact, James' life was so transformed by the gospel (through hearing it directly and reading God's word) that he wanted his friends to hear it as well. He is now being discipled

by David, taking an active part in ministry efforts, and discipling a number of fellow students, helping equip them to reach their friends.



I enjoyed meeting David in Thailand and sharing stories about what God is doing throughout East Asia.

This is a great example of how people's spiritual journeys reflect a process. It often takes several hearings of the gospel in the context of relationship and time in order for a person to be ready to trust Christ.
