The weather is not the only big change around here...Katie decided it was time to donate over 12 inches to Locks of Love for the second time. She loves it and she is beautiful inside and out.

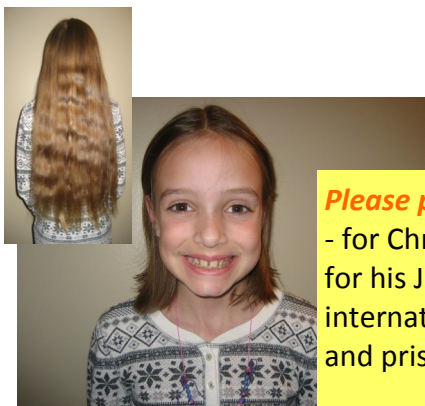
