Please pray about participating in whatever way you can. Your smile, hug, and encouragement may be the best gift they receive this Christmas. Another way you can help is to serve as a **Host** to a child and their family on the day of the event Sunday, December 6. You will greet them when they arrive at 4pm, show them around, take them to the crafts area, take them to the sanctuary for the program at 5pm, bring them back down and eat with them at 6pm and continue to shadow them as they enjoy the special guest until they leave, all the while talking and sharing the love of Jesus with them and their family as they enjoy fun, and fellowship.
