Dear Canton First Family, Do we push ourselves enough? It's easy to get into a routine, become comfortable with that routine, and limit our lives to the scope of the familiar. Is that what God wants us to do?

If the Bible is a reliable witness to God's preferences (and I believe it is), then no. God calls an old man to leave everything he's known behind, tells a murderer with a speech impediment to lead a nation out of bondage, repeatedly calls on the weak to rise up powerfully, and saved the world with a carpenter's son who was born into homelessness. So the familiar doesn't seem that interesting to God. This September, and October, as the leaves and temperatures turn, I hope you'll look beyond the limits of familiarity to where God might lead you. It's intimidating, I know, but you won't be alone. I will be doing likewise.

In October, I've been asked to do two things I have never done before in one event. I will be preaching a revival (never done that) in a church whose congregation is predominantly composed of African Americans attendees. All of them that I have met are exceedingly nice, welcoming, and in no way threatening but it is still a frightening thought. Is this something I am capable of doing? Will I disappoint them, myself, or the God I serve? You see, even when God gifts us for tasks, being called beyond the limits of familiarity can be scary. Most things worth doing, however, are terrifying. I hope you will expand your hori-

zons as we head into the fall. With new Bible studies starting (one tonight, as I write this, will begin studying missions, and I hope you will attend), new mission opportunities, new people to reach who are moving into town each day, the opportunities are endless.
