

It is no secret that I love missions. I love it because I love people. I love it because I love God. I love it because I love the church, and I believe the church cannot exist apart from being a collection of those who love God by loving people. So, with my logic clearly defined, let me explain why I love you. It is hard for a missions-minded pastor to be involved in a church that does not value missions. It is frustrating. It is like starving while staring at a buffet to which you are not allowed access. There is so much hurt in the world, so many problems, and so many people who need the love of God in their lives either knowingly or unknowingly, and we see it all around us. Mission-minded people take notice of all of the darkness that surrounds us, and we desperately long to help. To be more accurate, we desperately long for God to intervene through us. That is why I am so thankful to be in a mission-minded church. In other words, that is why I am so thankful for you. I have not always been in churches that cared for those from whom the world turns its metaphorical head. I have served churches that care more for themselves than those God sends their way. I have served churches that care more for tradition or their glorious pasts than for what God could do with them in their present. In a way, I am thankful for those churches as well. I learned a lot when I served them. They helped make me who I am, flaws and all. But as I think about the year that just ended, with so much opportunity to help so many, I am once again thankful for you, because you helped. You gave so that even if you could not help, others could. You supported the missions of Canton-FBC in some way, and it changed lives. It

As I talk with my friends, colleagues, classmates and others who have learned to serve God by serving people alongside me through the years. most of these people who are just as mission-minded as I am tend to smile but also roll their eyes. When I ask why, they usually offer a reply similar to the following: "On one hand, I'm so sorry that your community has gone through so much, but on the other, I'm so glad for you that you have a church around you that genuinely cares and wants to help." As we look ahead to the following year, there is still plenty to be done. We are still helping mill families. Without meaning to we have become the model warmth item provider that other organizations are now copying. We are meeting the needs of neighbors and all of this is possible because you give your time, your efforts, your ideas, your money, and perhaps most importantly, your permission. I have never asked to start any program that reaches out to our community and been told no. This is the first church I have ever served that allowed me to make that statement truthfully. The question, though, is simple. What is next? All of the things we have done are important, but God is not done here. So, as the new year marches forward, we want to hear from you. If you have ideas about how to continue to serve our community, we want to hear them. If you want to learn more about something, in Bible studies or worship settings, we want to hear that. We want to hear from you, because you are no less guided by God than anyone that stands behind a microphone on Sunday mornings. You matter, as do your ideas.

I should offer a disclaimer. We want to hear them, but that does not mean that we are capable of pulling them off at any given time. Please do not let that stop you from sharing. We want to hear what God puts on your mind, and I promise that we will take all ideas under careful consideration. This church cares for its community. It loves God by loving its members and neighbors. It serves well because it serves together, because we are one. We are different, but we are one, and that is what the family of God was created to be in the first place.
