## God Is Moving

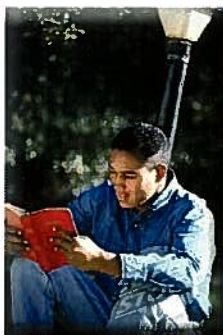


I like the phrase from the movie Princess Bride where as Miracle Max and his wife wave goodbye, they say, "Have fun storming the castle."

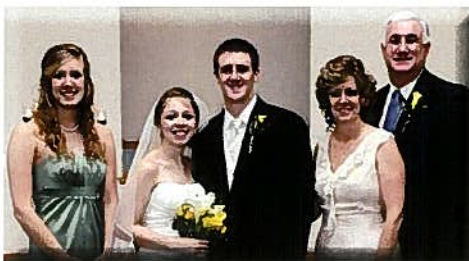
We're so happy for both of them! They really are a great couple together!
