Sami has successfully passed all of her interviews and has been accepted for an upper-level management program with her store. Now begins her 18-months of training and supervision for her future store-manager position.

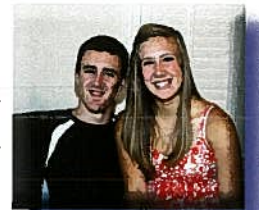
Their ministry year is also winding down at Texas State, so they’ll get a little break now.
