AN UPDATE FROM ADEL

Many of you have asked Jack how I am doing and said that you are praying for me. Thank you, I am so grateful! Prayer makes the difference because we have a God who hears and answers. I have my up and down days. Right now I have pericarditis (inflammation of the lining of the heart). It is one of the possible complications of having systemic lupus. Jack asked me to share what I have learned during this time. Probably the three most prominent things are: (1) God is faithful even when I fail Him; He never changes and is true to His word. (2) He said He'd never leave or forsake us and has told us, "My presence will go with you and I will give you rest." (Exodus 33:14) His presence is my strength! And (3) He grants us peace in every situation. John 14:27 reads, "Peace I leave with you, my peace I give to you." In the midst of every difficult situation His peace has become my peace. I am so grateful for His presence!
