

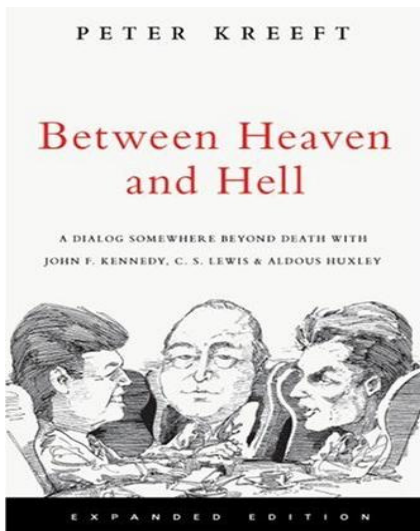

## JFK, C.S. Lewis, and Huxley Argue



I remember when I first studied apologetics (reasons to believe). A great peace came to me when I realized my heart and my head did not need to be in conflict. My heart wanted to believe in God and what He had done for me, but my mind needed intellectual assurance. I find similar

needs amongst students to understand with their heart and mind.

We have an apologetics class this quarter where no question is off limits. Is God good? Are the Scriptures reliable? Is the meaning of the Scriptures dependant upon who is interpreting them?

We will study a couple good books by Peter Kreeft, "Between Heaven and Hell" and "Socrates Meets Jesus." These are humorous but serious looks at the claims of Christ in a dialogue form. In the first, John F. Kennedy, C. S. Lewis, and Aldous Huxley discuss the meaning of life and death. They all died the same day. In the second, history's greatest philosopher asks some probing questions of students and faculty at the Have It Divinity School (Harvard).

The Christian students have found the arguments helpful.
