Method

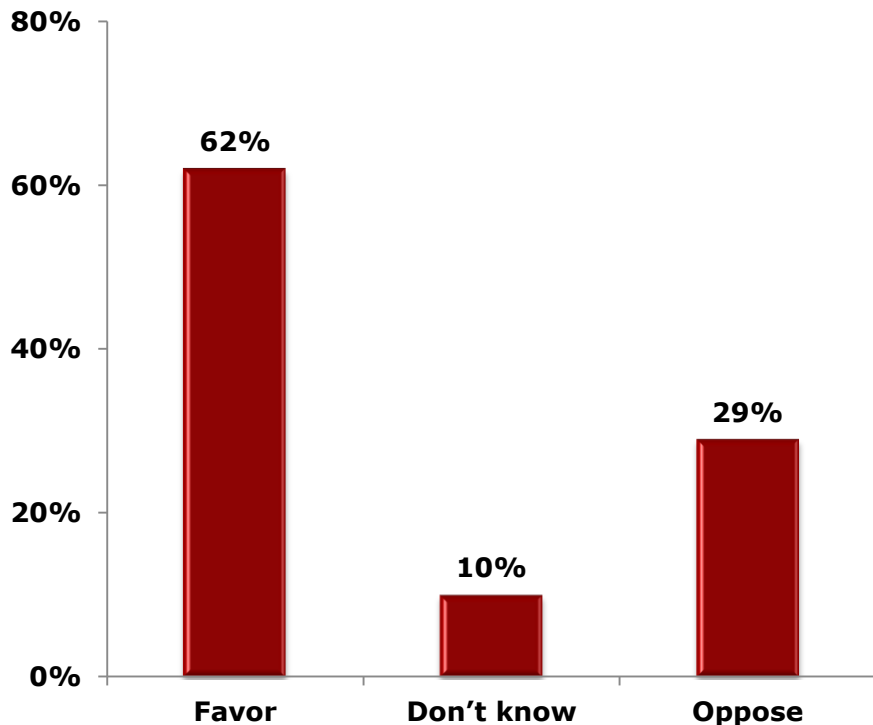
Landline and cell phone interviews conducted January 10 & 12, 2013.

Sampling Error

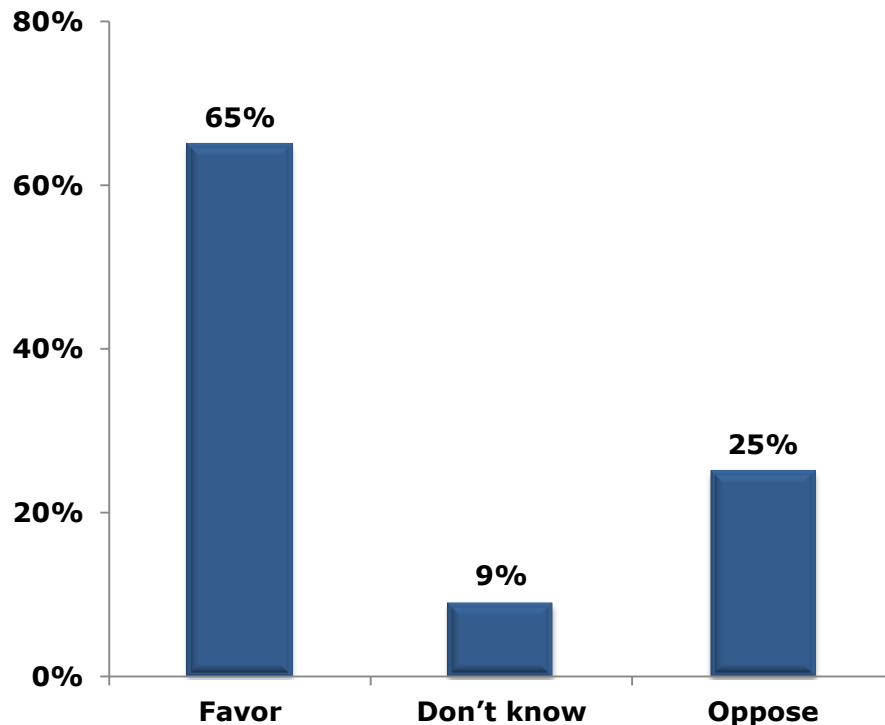
Plus or minus 4% at the 95% confidence level.

Majority Favor Parent Involvement and Parental Notification

“Do you favor or oppose a law that would require **parents to be involved** in a decision to have an abortion for girls under age 18?” (Q1)



“Do you favor or oppose a law that would require **parents to be notified** before a girl under age 18 could have an abortion?” (Q2)
