INVEST

Designed as a dual set of 3-year programs for 1st -6th graders. The students will take classes of study and participate in a service project group.

Students will be separated into two grade level groups for class time and then be combined for service project time.

INVEST JR.

Designed for 3's-K's to learn more about the Bible and service. Teachers will utilize "The Beginner's Bible" and accompanying curriculum to lay a biblical foundation. Concepts will be reinforced through craft and guided activities.

Students will participate in an interactive teaching time with the lead teacher and then break into gender specific small groups with an adult mentor. During class time students will work on scripture memorization and application. Those participating in certification will also be given an opportunity to complete a quarterly project which will be displayed in the end of the year Showcase.

CLASSES

1. HIStory: Chronology of the Bible
With the help of the lead teacher and mentors:

Focus: Students will read through the Bible using The Picture Bible.

Expand: Students will create a timeline of biblical events and discuss 21 major biblical themes.

2. Discipleship

Through guided discussions and teaching time:

Focus: Students will complete Bill Bright's Children's Discipleship series.

Expand: Students will complete Francis Chan's "Multiply."

3. Voyage Through the Bible

Through hands-on activities and instruction:

Focus: Students will memorize the books of the Bible, their order, and categorical designations. They will also learn about the author and key people of each book.

Expand: Students will use "30 Days to Understanding The Bible" to learn about the structure, geography, eras, and doctrines of the Bible.

Service Groups

During registration students and parents can choose which service path they would like to take.

Express

“Giving voice to God’s truth.” Students will express God’s truth through a variety of mediums: spoken word, singing, drama, and corporate prayer.

Magnify

“Magnify the Word and love of God through service and relationships.” Students will develop relationships with missionaries and their families. They will also learn different types of serving culminating in a service project.

Theme Nights

There will be a total of 4-5 theme nights throughout the year. During these nights we will have a themed dress-up and a time of review.



Showcase

At the end of the year students will be given the opportunity to share their accomplishments.

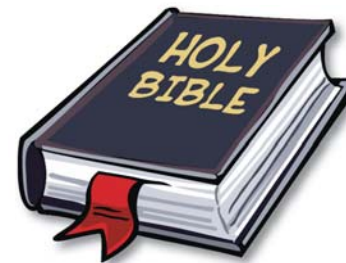


INVEST Schedule
