

Students may not miss ANY days of camp, and must participate in BOTH performances. (Director may make exceptions in cases of illness.) The registration fee is non-refundable.

STUDENT INSTRUMENTALISTS – PRE-CAMP AUDITIONS

 Students desiring to play with the CFAC Orchestra on 1 or more songs must participate in instrumental auditions PRIOR to the start of camp, on <u>Monday, July 10, at 5:00 pm</u>.

(If needed, an alternate audition time can be arranged by contacting the director at 327-5921 on or before that date.)

- Students participating in the CFAC instrumental auditions MUST have a *minimum* of one year of school instruction on instrument(s) OR 6 months of private instruction on instrument(s)
- Students should come to auditions prepared to:

 Play a scale appropriate for skill level in key of their choice
 Play a short piece of their choice
 Depending on skill level, student may be asked to sight read music during the audition

 Students cannot participate in the CFAC Orchestra unless they participate in the pre-
- Students cannot participate in the CFAC Orchestra unless they participate in the precamp auditions on or before July 10.

SHOW PLACEMENT AUDITIONS

- **ALL STUDENTS** will participate in placement auditions during camp on Tuesday, **July 18**, for drama roles, solos, ensembles, and choreography groups.
- Specific audition information, including audition script, songs, etc., will be distributed on the first day of camp.

IMPORTANT CAMP INFO

- Students will not have access to **cell phones** during camp. Please call the church at <u>327-5921</u> if you must reach them.
- Each student should bring **<u>2 dozen cookies</u>** with them when checking-in on the first day.
- There is a **MANDATORY PARENT MEETING** from 2-2:30pm on the first day of camp.
- The registration fee includes a book and CD of the musical, camp t-shirt, and snacks. <u>LUNCH IS NOT PROVIDED</u>, and students must bring a lunch <u>every day</u>.
- A costuming fee of <u>no more than \$10 per student</u> may be required at the start of camp.
