SCHOOL MISSION

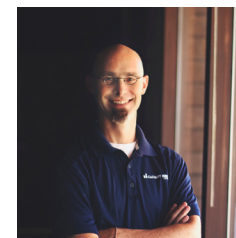
opus: noun, \ˈō-pəs\

Workshops

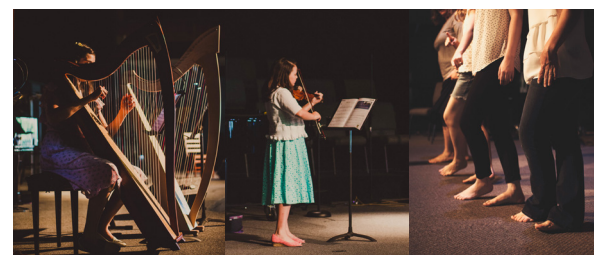
Students will learn and develop together through interactive workshops. These typically occur 1-2 times per semester.
