

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

At Opus48, we believe that each person is an artistic work of God, uniquely gifted with talents and passions. Our teachers seek to develop students into skillful artists and communicators who turn performance into a spectacular outpouring of their gifts — their opus.

Opus48 School of Performing Arts offers **need-based scholarships**. These scholarships are granted at the discretion of the School Director and Leadership Team. Scholarships are based on a family's financial need.

Because we understand that the desire for assistance is great, we take the awarding of scholarships very seriously and look to be good stewards of the money that is provided by our donors. Just as with all Opus48 students, there is an expectation that scholarship students, along with their parents/guardians, would not have excessive absences, would show a commitment to practice, and maintain a positive attitude. Scholarships can be reduced or revoked at any time if these expectations are not met.

Students in need of scholarships must apply each August prior to the start of lessons. For Spring semester and/or Summer session lessons, scholarship recipients must confirm their intent to continue in lessons and their continued financial need. The Fall semester scholarship application must be resubmitted or updated for reevaluation to determine Spring and/or Summer scholarships.

After review of your application by the Scholarship Committee, you will be notified of the committee's decision at the email address that we have on file.

Spring 2018 Scholarship Application Deadline: Wednesday, December 20, 2017
