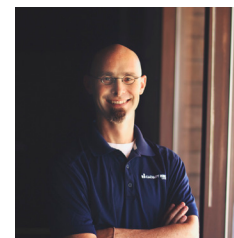

Students will learn and develop together through interactive workshops. These typically occur 1-2 times per semester.

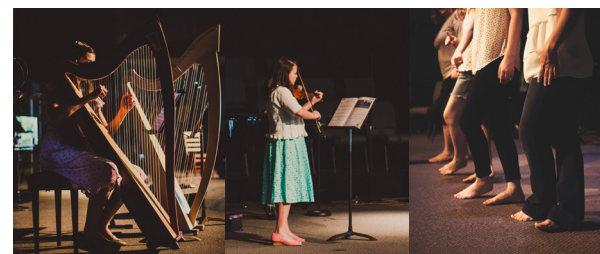
Ministry Arts Groups
