Focus students will:

- Read through the entire Bible in chronological order.
- Participate in small group discussions.
- Learn and utilize the inductive study method.

Expand students will:

- Create a timeline of events using The Picture Bible.
- Learn about 21 major themes of the Bible.
- Participate in small group discussions.

Discipleship

Through guided discussions and teaching time:

Focus:

In Bill Bright's books:

- <u>Beginning the Christian Adventure</u>, students will learn, "who Jesus is and how they can experience the life that Jesus has provided for each believer.
- <u>Discovering our Awesome God</u>, students will learn, "who God is and how He relates to us through His Holy Spirit."
- <u>Building an Active Faith</u>, students will learn how to, "grow as a believer, including the importance of giving our whole selves to God, witnessing of His work in our life, and obeying Him."

Expand:
