2019 Memory Care Seminar for Caregivers at Home

It is happening on Saturday, March 23 at 9:30AM – 12:00AM at Martha & Mary Health and Rehab Center in Poulsbo.

This event is directed at individuals caring for persons living with dementia or Alzheimer's Disease at home, but is valuable to anyone facing cognitive decline issues within their family.

Our seminar will begin with Rosalys Peel, local author of "Mike & Me," which describes how Ms. Peel cared for her late husband at home after his Alzheimer's Disease diagnosis. The book provides both warm, insightful tales of her experience, plus excellent information for in-home caregivers about resources she discovered around Kitsap to support her husband's care and quality of life.
