- 19. When he was set down on the judgment seat, his wife sent unto him, saying, Have thou nothing to do with that just man: for I have suffered many things this day in a dream because of him.
- 20. But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.
- 21. The governor answered and said unto them, Whether of the twain will ye that I release unto you? They said, Barabbas.
- 22. Pilate saith unto them, What shall I do then with Jesus which is called Christ? They all say unto him, Let him be crucified.


