25. ***And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.***
26. *His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed:*
27. ***Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury.***
28. *Take therefore the talent from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents.*
29. ***For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.***
30. ***And cast ye the unprofitable servant into outer darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth.***
