Responsive Reading - I Samuel 8:4-11, 16-20

- 4. Then all the elders of Israel gathered themselves together, and came to Samuel unto Ramah,
- 5. And said unto him, Behold, thou art old, and thy sons walk not in thy ways: now make us a king to judge us like all the nations.
- 6. But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD.
- 7. And the LORD said unto Samuel, Hearken unto the voice of the people in all that they say unto thee: for they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them.
- 8. According to all the works which they have done since the day that I brought them up out of Egypt even unto this day, wherewith they have forsaken me, and served other gods, so do they also unto thee.
- 9. Now therefore hearken unto their voice: howbeit yet protest solemnly unto them, and shew them the manner of the king that shall reign over them.
- 10. And Samuel told all the words of the LORD unto the people that asked of him a king.
- 11. And he said, This will be the manner of the king that shall reign over you: He will take your sons, and appoint them for himself, for his chariots, and to be his horsemen; and some shall run before his chariots.
- 16. And he will take your menservants, and your maidservants, and your goodliest young men, and your asses, and put them to his work.
- 17. He will take the tenth of your sheep: and ye shall be his servants.
- 18. And ye shall cry out in that day because of your king which ye shall have chosen you; and the LORD will not hear you in that day.
- 19. Nevertheless the people refused to obey the voice of Samuel; and they said, Nay; but we will have a king over us;
- 20. That we also may be like all the nations; and that our king may judge us, and go out before us, and fight our battles.
