Family & Friends Day

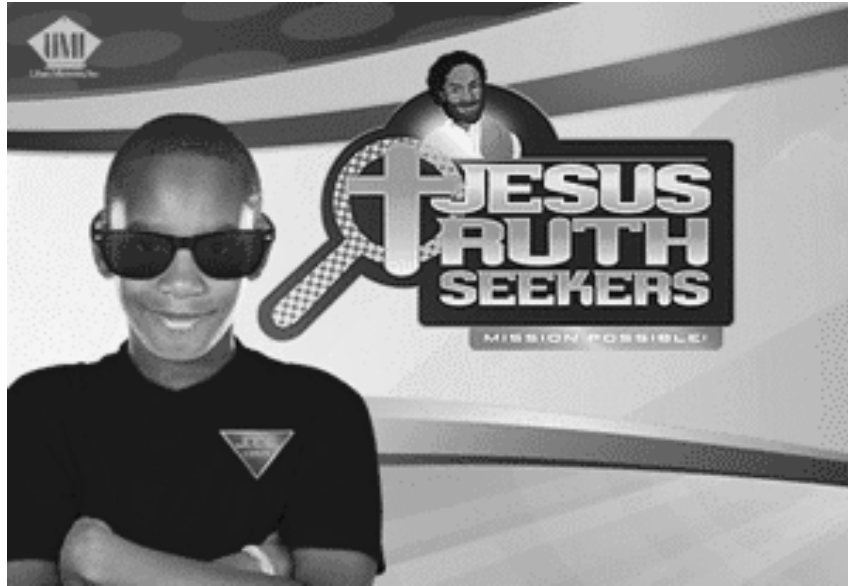
