All ministry leaders are asked to meet at the back of the church immediately after service this morning. This will be a very short but very important meeting regarding the 2013 church calendar.



Rev. Dr. David Thomas, Jr. was licensed to preach in 1990 by the late Rev. Jay Hills and the St. Paul #1 Baptist Church of Wilson, LA. In September 1991 he was installed as Pastor of that church where he continues to Pastor today. He also organized and now Pastors the New Beginnings Baptist Church of West Baton Rouge. Rev. Dr. Thomas previously served as Pastor of the Flower Mount Baptist Church of Ethel, LA. Rev.
