Fred Jeff Smith is a native of Baton Rouge, Louisiana, the second of three children born to Rev. Charles T. Smith and the late Mrs. Winstonia M. Smith. He received his secondary education at Baton Rouge High Magnet School. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from Louisiana State University in 1983, and received his Master of Divinity degree from New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary in 1986, in the Division of Pastoral Ministries.

From 1986 to 1992, Rev. Smith served as Pastor of the First Free Mission Baptist Church of New Orleans. Since March, 1992, he has served as Pastor of the Greater Mount Carmel Baptist Church of Scotlandville. Additionally, he serves as a Special Assistant to the Pastor of the Shiloh Missionary Baptist Church.

Rev.
