Elder Brandon M. Smith is a lifelong member of Richardson Chapel Church of God in Christ, under the leadership of Superintendent Charles H. Gordon. Smith serves as the local Youth Department Director and is a co-founder of the Youth Spiritual Empowerment Conference. Smith is currently the Minister of Music and also serves as a Sunday School teacher and member of the Leadership Team.

Smith is graduate of Scotlandville Magnet High School. He continued his studies at Louisiana State University, receiving a bachelor's degree in Political Science/International Law and Politics with a minor in African and African American Studies. It was in his senior year that Smith accepted his calling to preach the Gospel.

Following graduation, Smith served for two years as a Teach For America® corps member and taught fourth grade at Brookstown Elementary in Baton Rouge, LA. He is now employed at his alma mater, LSU, as the Community Affairs Liaison. In this position, Smith is the primary contact between the university and the neighboring Old South Baton Rouge Community. He is also responsible for building and maintaining external partnerships with non-profit organizations. Smith is the youngest son of Deacon Robert and Katie Baker Smith; he is married to the former Rachanda Wilson and they have two children, Katelyn Metielle and Wilson Parker.
