- 7. And said unto him, Go, wash in the pool of Siloam, (which is by interpretation, Sent.) He went his way therefore, and washed, and came seeing.
- 13. They brought to the Pharisees him that aforetime was blind.
- 14. And it was the sabbath day when Jesus made the clay, and opened his eyes.
- 15. Then again the Pharisees also asked him how he had received his sight. He said unto them, He put clay upon mine eyes, and I washed, and do see.
- 24. Then again called they the man that was blind, and said unto him, Give God the praise: we know that this man is a sinner.
- 25. He answered and said, Whether he be a sinner or no, I know not: one thing I know, that, whereas I was blind, now I see.
- 26. Then said they to him again, What did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes?
- 27. He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear it again? will ye also be his disciples?
- 28. Then they reviled him, and said, Thou art his disciple; but we are Moses' disciples.
- 29. We know that God spake unto Moses: as for this fellow, we know not from whence he is.
- 30. The man answered and said unto them, Why herein is a marvellous thing, that ye know not from whence he is, and yet he hath opened mine eyes.
