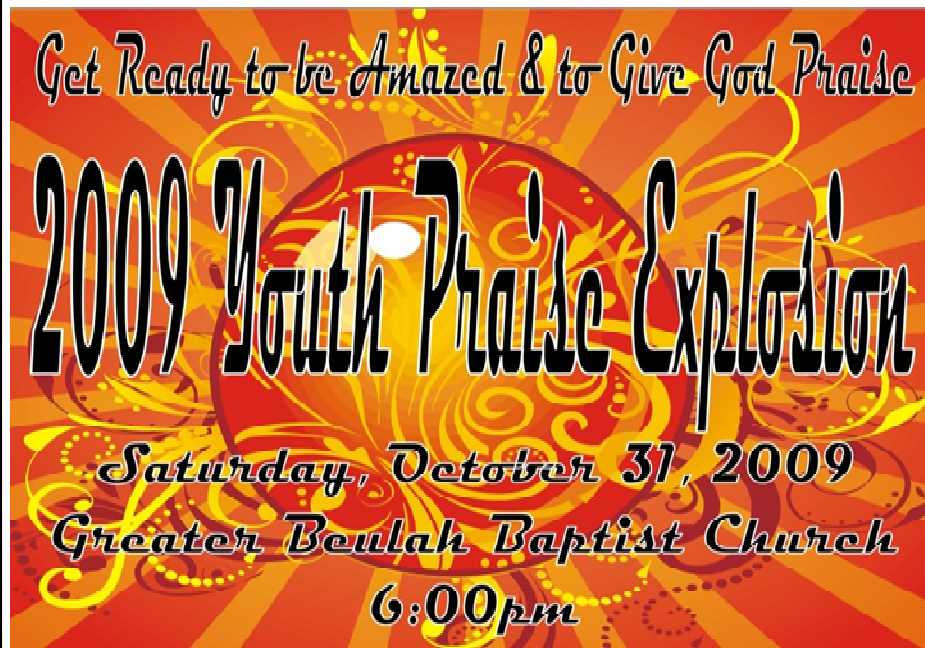
Youth Praise Explosion
