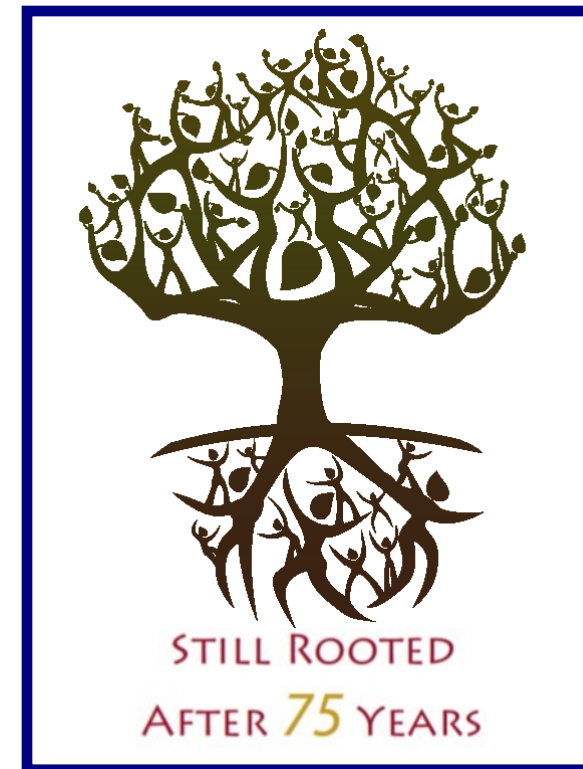

If there is a line growing at the soup table, stop by and view the slide show on the TV monitor, take a look at the memorabilia from the past, purchase a new coffee mug for \$10, and don't forget to write a personal note or reflection of a specific event on our lovely timeline at the back of the gym. To help you figure out which nametag you should pick up, here is the key:

❖ 50 plus years: Before 1967=Gold nametags

❖ 40 plus years: 1968-1977=Green nametags

❖ 30 plus years: 1978-1987=Red nametags

❖ 20 plus years: 1988-1997=Silver nametags

❖ 10 plus years: 1998-2007=Blue nametags

❖ Less than 10 years: 2008 until today=Yellow nametags
