LIGHTING THE ADVENT CANDLE (Judy David-Hope and Janet Budke)

On this second Sunday in Advent, we hear the words of John the Baptist who calls us to repentance. We know that all is not right with us or with our world. There is strife within and without, brokenness too, and yet we live in hope. Hear the words of the prophet Isaiah: "A child has been born for us, a son given to us; authority rests upon his shoulders; and he is named Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of peace. His authority shall grow continually, and there shall be endless peace for the throne of David and his kingdom. He will establish and up hold it with justice and with righteousness from this time onward and forevermore." (Isaiah 9:6,7) We light this candle as a symbol of the light of Christ who has come and continues to come into the world. With Christ comes the light of peace, which is wholeness.

All: Let us walk in the light of the Lord, who is our hope and our peace. Amen.
