LIGHTING THE ADVENT CANDLE (The Teed Family)

The season of preparation is half over. We have heard John the Baptist's call to repentance. The day of the celebration of Christ's birth approaches and we wait in joyful anticipation, for Christ is not only our hope and our peace, Christ is also our joy. Hear the words of the prophet Isaiah: "The ransomed of the Lord shall return, and come to Zion with singing, everlasting joy shall be upon their heads; they shall obtain joy and gladness, and sorrow and sighing shall flee away." (Isaiah 35:10) We light this pink candle as a symbol of the light of Christ who has come and continues to come into the world. With Christ comes the light of joy.
