

cer awareness month. It is reported that most people who die from breast cancer found out too late. There is now an emphasis on early detection, Early detection is vitally important in the fight for the cure. Many low income households are not insured and therefore don't receive adequate or proper, timely care. Signs of breast caner can be detected by finding a lump in the breast or an abnormal mammogram. There are four stages of breast cancer. There are different forms of breast cancer. Breast cancer is not uncommon in men and must be taken seriously. There are 5 stages of breast cancer ranging from 0-4, stage 0 abnormal cancer cells visible not tissues, stage 1 in tissues about the size of a peanut has not spread out side breast, stage 2 may have spread to lymph nodes under the arm, stage 3 spreading to lymph nodes, chest wall, and underarm near neck and glands, stage 4 also called metastasized breast cancer could be spread to the lungs, liver, and or brain. *lymph nodes are the bodies filters for helping to fight off illnesses. Conduct monthly self breast exams, Have periodic breast exams and done by your physician and remember early detection is vitally important to curing breast cancer.
