Most of us readily agree that Morris Booker Williams Community Resource Center has served the Regular AR Missionary Baptist Convention for many years, providing Christian Education for conventioneers and others throughout the state of AR. Currently, the center provides an in -kind (free) community youth service program that has enhanced the youth activities for the city of Dermott. The After School program offers tutoring and training in computer skills to help students become productive citizens. It serves 150-200 students, daily. Unfortunately, there are no funds to support the \$160,000 tab for roof repairs on the library, gym, daycare, cafeteria, as well as other items for building maintenance. The building's current appraisal value is \$70,000 determined during a recent on-site appraisal. A Town Hall meeting for the purpose of creating a partnership between the Dermott community, Regular AR Baptist Convention, the State, county and city governments, was held on Thursday, October 20, 2011.
