- (1) Where do all the resources in the world come from? GOD... Psalms 24:1 "The earth is the Lord's and everything in it, the world and all who live in it."
- (2) Can I ever be free from financial problems? YES! Proverbs 10:22 "The blessing of the Lord brings wealth and he adds no trouble to you."
