Our nursery provides a loving, warm environment for infants through age three. It is divided into three sections; sleepers, crawlers, and walkers, to ensure your child's safety.

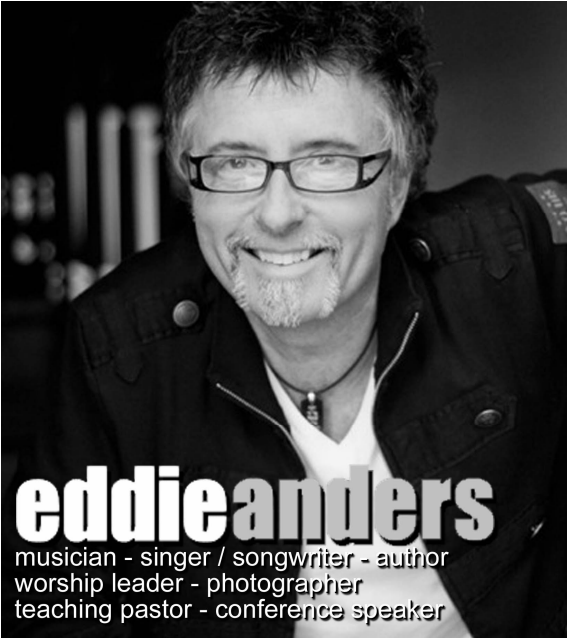

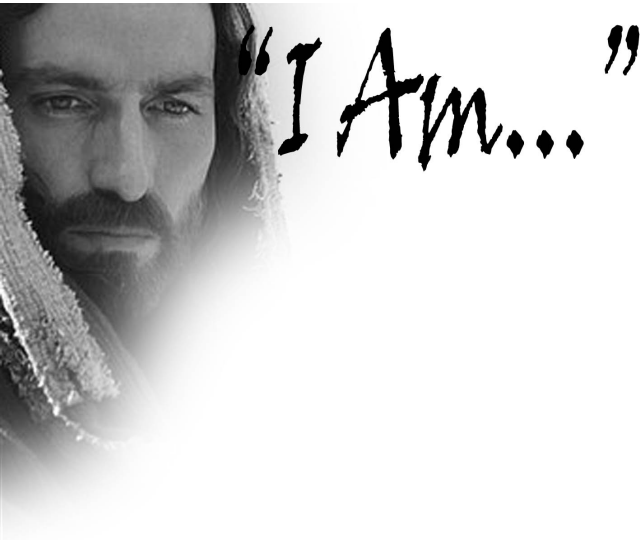

# SERMON NOTES



Science tells us that light is constituted of three rays, or groups of wavelengths, distinct from each other, no one of which without the others would be light. Each ray has its own separate function.

- The first ray originates. It is often called invisible light that is nei-ther seen, nor felt.
- The second ray formulates, illuminates or manifests. The second ray is both seen and felt.
- The third ray consummates. It is not seen, but is felt as heat.
