- Putting out offering envelopes & Pens in each seat, etc.

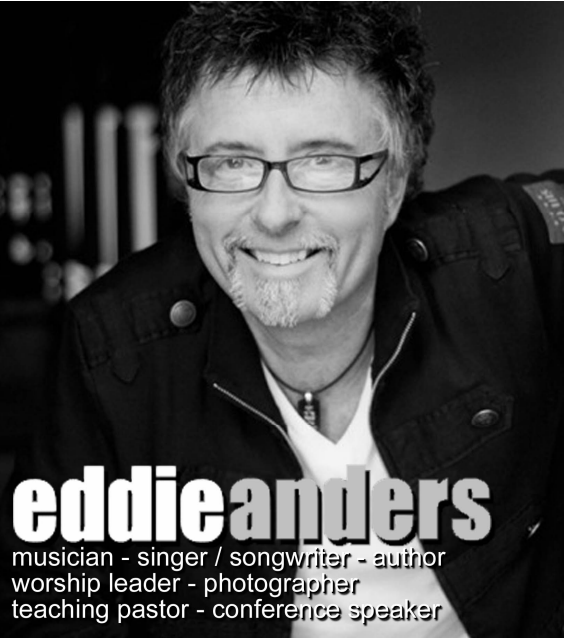
