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Pressing Forward

In March of this year I sat in a meeting at work and listened as my Director advised us that no one at the company would be receiving a salary increase this year. It was now my job to explain to my Supervisors and Associates the same information. I remember thinking, "This past year was one of my best years, as well as many others at the company, and how could they not reward any of us when we had more profit this year than the last.... However, it is a blessing we didn't get laid off." I listened to many Associates and co-workers in despair, most posing the same question to me, how will I pay my bills now; I was counting on that raise? I answered them all the same and encouraged myself in the process to.....Press Forward.

A few weeks ago, my husband called me at work to advise that he just left a meeting and everyone's salary would be cut, his hours would be reduced, and he was informed that most of his department functions would be outsourced in the next two years. He asked me what I thought and for a quick moment I recalled our bills and the vision we had been working on and I was concerned. My response to him, in a attempt to encourage myself as well once again was.....We will Press Forward.

Philippians 3:13-15 says, Brethren, I count not myself to have apprehended: but this one thing I do, forgetting those things which are behind, and reaching forth unto those things which are before, I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of God in Christ Jesus. Let us therefore, as many as be perfect, be thus minded: and if in any thing ye be otherwise minded, God shall reveal even this unto you. Many today are faced with downsizing and layoffs and instead of being in despair; this passage is telling us to Press Forward, looking to the Lord to reveal his plan to us. While waiting on the Lord's plan to be revealed to me, I remember a familiar bible verse, "Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feedeth them: how much

more are ye better than the fowls? (*Luke 12:24*). This passage serves as a reminder that the Lord never stops providing and making provisions for us; this includes every area of our lives. God's idea of provision is oftentimes different

than ours though. For example, my husband has been talking to me about having more time to work on the vision for our family and possibly go back to school for his MBA. With the changes on his job, he now works 4 days a week, giving him more time to spend with our boys and pursue our vision/schooling. I wanted to work closer to home to spend more time with my son in the evening; I was then laid off from my job and received a job closer to home with an increase in salary.

The reason you are getting the wrong answers is because you are asking the wrong questions.

What I didn't Ask

I didn't have to ask why I lost my job, I knew why. I didn't need to ask how I ended in divorce, I knew how I never had to seek understanding why others were trying to kill me, I understood And no, I certainly did not wonder how I came to be homeless for the answers to all Of these questions starred at me from my reflection.

<u>What I did Ask</u>

I asked how could all of this happen when I was trying to do the right thing.

I wondered why my life was getting worse when I am trying to get my life right with God

And I just knew I would never in a million years understand why The Lord wanted Me to help those who tried to destroy me.

What the Lord Did

The Lord healed me through His Word and the Touch of His Hand on my Life.

Everything I did according to His Will, He magnified and multiplied beyond What I could have thought to do for myself.

And I knew for every scar engraved in my soul that it was not a symbol of pain. But one of testimony of how the Lord in every instance healed and made me whole again.

The reason we ask the wrong questions is because seeking what we want separates us from what the Lord wants for us.

First of all...

In today's economy, professional representation is vital. Many times we short change ourselves because we do not know how to adequately communicate our skill set in resumes and cover letters. The samples next page are templates from MS Word.

In addition to your job responsibilities, you can also include accomplishments you were involved in. The examples should be brief and answer three questions: What was the problem? What did you do? What was the results? Usually you want to indicate how you helped productivity or the company save money.

Cover Letter

This is where you want to demonstrate your interest in working specifically for this company. Do not attempt to rewrite your resume in the cover letter. Many postings and ads not only indicate you to include a cover letter, but also what to put in it. Make sure you include what is being requested of you. Adding some keywords is permissible; just don't overdo it.

Keep it light and to the point. Despite your situation, you want to communicate yourself as a strong candidate best suited for the job instead of a desperate job seeker.

Resume

Due to the high number of resumes being submitted on a daily, many companies use resume scanning software. This software is used to scan for keywords. If the software does not locate the minimum keywords set, your resume will never be seen.

Although it may easier and quicker to use one resume to apply to different positions, you may be easing your way out of an opportunity. Review the keywords in the employment posting / add. The criteria and skill set they are looking for are probably the basis for majority of the keywords they search for within a resume. Take time to customize your resume to fit the position you are applying for. This will increase your chances.

FAQs

- How do I get experience?

 A) You may want to consider volunteering part time in an area you are trying to improve upon. Be sure to treat this opportunity as you would a job. You never know what the Lord will bless you with.
- 2. How do I get a better job?

A) Research the skills that are being asked of the job you want to get. Start asking to be trained or help out in these areas. Sometimes it will mean more work but you will take this knowledge with you wherever you go.

3. I am not being recognized for my ideas and effort. What do I do?

A) Document your ideas, develop yourself / pray to the Lord in how you may use them.
